## MINUTES TO MEETING December 21, 2021, 6:00 p.m.

The City Council for the City of Big Sandy met in Regular Session on December 21, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., at the City of Big Sandy Heritage Center, 162 E. Gilmer Street, Big Sandy, Texas.

Call to Order: Mayor Rozell called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

- **c. MEMBERS PRESENT:** Mayor Rex Rozell, Linda Baggett, Becky Desborough, David Fonteno, Christine Jones, and Andrew McIver.
- d. STAFF PRESENT: Chief David Easterling and Laura Rex.
- e. OTHERS PRESENT: Joy Clark, Sonny Parsons, Doug Peterson, Lisa Werner, Ed Williams, Interim Fire Chief Stephen Winchell, Michael Wilson and Sarah Wilson.

## **Consent Agenda:**

- 1. Minutes of Meetings: Jones requested the minutes be considered separate from the Financials. Jones moved to approve the Nov. 15 and Nov. 16 minutes and to table the Oct. 19<sup>th</sup> minutes (which were not on this meeting's agenda for approval) and the Nov. 24<sup>th</sup> minutes. McIver seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- **2. Financial Reports for November 2021:** Fonteno moved to approve as presented and Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 3. Volunteer Fire Department: Monthly Report and Replacement of Repeater at Wildcat Water Tower: Chief Winchell reported the power supply has gone out on the repeater. Fonteno moved to accept the bid for a Motorola repeater installed by Mobile Comm. America at a cost of \$11,610.92 with any needed line item budget transfers that might be necessary and Jones seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- **4. Darold Cuba: Request to name street in honor Bobby Mitchell:** Baggett moved to approve the request to name a street in honor of Bobby Mitchell, giving Mr. Mitchell the choice between Bryan and Robert Streets and Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 8. Request for change in zoning: Doug Peterson: 312 W Broadway/232 W Gilmer: Block 47, Lot 7: Doug Peterson addressed the council and requested a change in zoning for this property.
- **12. Zoning: set date for public hearing regarding Agenda Item (8):** Fonteno moved to set a public hearing for the proposed change in zoning of Block 47, Lot 7 and Jones seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.

- 5. Water bill adjustment: George Eaton: 217 W Gilmer: Desborough moved to adjust this water bill by \$75.20 and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 6. Water Tap Permit: Circle M Partners: 14487 Highway 155: Mr. Williams reported he will be starting construction on 4 new homes and has requested a 2" water connection. Jones moved to start a Non-standard service investigation to determine the cost of providing service to this location outside the city limits, pending the Circle M Partners agreeing to pay for the cost and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 7. Request for Annexation: Circle M Partners: 14550 Hwy 155: No action taken.
- 9. Police Department: Monthly Report: Chief Easterling presented the November 2021 report.
- **10. Public Works Department: Monthly Report:** Mr. Rogers was not present but the monthly report was provided in the council packet.
  - a. Covers for backflow devices @ Big Sandy VFD & Big Sandy Park: No action taken.
  - **b.** Sanitary Sewer improvements on W Gilmer Street: Fonteno moved to go out for bids for the improvements excluding the cost of repairing the street and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 11. Street Repairs: Update: No action taken.
- 13. Resolution adopting 2022 Holidays for the City of Big Sandy: Fonteno moved to approve Resolution #2021-034 adopting the 2022 Holidays to be all of the federal holidays except Columbus day and including the Friday after thanksgiving and Christmas Eve. McIver seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 14. Code Red Annual Fee: Baggett moved to approve the annual fee for February 2021 January 2022 at a cost of \$1,575 and Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 15. EZ Task Website Annual Fees: Jones moved to approve the annual fee for February 2022 January 2023 at a cost of \$3,525 and Fonteno seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- **16. City Administrator Monthly Report:** Rex gave the monthly report covering Agenda Items 19. Mural for 119 E Gilmer Street) 20. (Painting of 119 Gilmer Street) 21. Civic Center: Internet Access: Jones moved to accept the bid from Frontier to install internet at the Civic Center located at 612 N Tyler Street for a one time installation fee of \$75 and a recurring monthly charge of \$89.95 and Fonteno seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones, and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- **18. 204 E Gilmer Street: Plan to stabilize building:** Rex will seek the cost of two options: demolition and putting a roof on. No action taken.
