MINUTES TO MEETING April 19, 2022, 6:00 p.m.

The City Council for the City of Big Sandy met in Regular Session on April 19, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., at the City of Big Sandy Heritage Center, 162 E. Gilmer Street, Big Sandy, Texas.

<u>Call to Order:</u> Mayor Rozell called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

- 3. Volunteer Fire Department: Monthly Report: Chief Winchell presented the monthly report, the department responded to 12 calls in March including 5 wildland fires.
- **4. Utility Bill Adjustment: Robert Cobb: 106 E Kay:** Jones moved to adjust the utility bill by \$163.94 and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 5. Utility Bill Adjustment: Zack Davenport: 101 West College: Baggett moved to adjust the bill by \$225.45; Jones seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 6. Utility Bill Adjustment: Kristin Ferguson: 908 Tyler: Fonteno moved to adjust the utility bill by \$40.00; Jones seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 7. Utility Bill Adjustment: La Vida Wesley: 205 Quitman: Jones moved to adjust the utility bill by \$471.15 and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Jones and McIver voted aye. Fonteno voted nay. Motion carried 4-1-0.
- 8. Water & Sewer Tap Permit: Iva Strickland: 400 Roberts St: Fonteno moved to approve the permits pending a letter from the wife of Johnny Brown (who is deceased) giving her approval for the applications. Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 9. Water & Sewer Tap Permit: Carolyn Derrick: Roberts St: This request was withdrawn.
- **10. Sewer Tap Permit: Dwayne Stanton: 235 W Gilmer:** Desborough moved to approve the tap permit & Fonteno seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.

- 11. Installation of Water Well: Shalom Abrams: Fonteno moved to take this item from the table and Baggett seconded; Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion to take this item from the table carried 5-o-o. PWD Rogers stated that the installation of water wells is prohibited by the city's ordinances.
- 12. Anthony Fail: Civic Center Rental Proposal: Fonteno moved to take this item from the table, Baggett seconded; Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones and McIver voted aye. Motion to take this item from the table carried 5-0-0. After discussion, Fonteno moved to approve a 6 month lease with the Refuge Church to lease the Civic Center on available Sundays pending Mr. Davis' review of the lease and approval by the Mayor & City Administrator. Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 13. David Fonteno: BS Area Lions Club Beautification Plan for City Park & Civic Center: Dr. Fonteno, President of the BS Area Lions Club, asked for permission to create a beautification program. Desborough moved to grant permission to create the plan and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno and Jones voted aye. McIver abstained. Motion carried 4-0-1.
- 14. Police Department: Monthly Report: Chief Easterling presented the monthly report.
- 15. Police Dept.: Purchase of DVD Duplicator: McIver moved to approve the purchase of the duplicator at a cost not to exceed \$800 including shipping and warranty and Fonteno seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 16. Public Works Department: Monthly Report: Mr. Rogers presented the monthly report.
- 17. Public Works: Installation of 200 amp manual transfer switches: McIver moved to accept the bid from Hill Electric for \$4525 and Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- **18. Nuisance Abatement: 200 S Meason:** Baggett moved to accept the demolition and cleanup of the property by AGLYN at a cost of \$8,500 and Fonteno seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 19. Traffic Control at intersection of Wimberly/College/Meason: Desborough moved to install a stop sign at this intersection immediately and McIver seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- **20. Truck Route for the City of Big Sandy:** Baggett moved to authorize Mayor Rozell to research a possible truck route for the S Tyler, E Gilmer and Wildcat Drive and Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 21. Resolution nominating candidate to the Upshur Co. Appraisal Dist. Board: No action taken.
- **22. Ordinance: Outdoor Siren Policy:** The city does not currently have a siren policy. The council will work on drafting a policy to be adopted at a future meeting. No action taken.
- **23. Resolution authorizing relocation of City Hall:** Baggett moved to approve **Resolution #2022-006** authorizing the relocation of City Hall to 119 E Gilmer, approving the proposed floor plan & hiring Arlon Tomes as the general contractor for the project at a cost not to exceed \$150,000; Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 24. City Administrator Monthly Report: Administrator Rex presented the monthly reports.

Minutes of Meeting(s): March 15, 2022; November 24, 2021: After discussion, McIver moved to approve the March 15, 2022 minutes as presented and the November 24, 2021 minutes as changed by the council. Desborough seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
- 2. Financial Reports for March 2022: Fonteno moved to approve the March 2022 financial reports as presented and Baggett seconded. Baggett, Desborough, Fonteno, Jones & McIver voted aye. Motion carried 5-0-0.
